Cuvee Marine, Domaine de Menard, Cote De Gascogne, France, 2015 <i>Colombard, Ugni Blanc, Gros Manseng</i> Elegant, floral notes. A good companion to spiced dishes. Shellfish fossils are found in the soil where the vines are grown, contributing to this wine's minerality.	6.25 / 12.5 / 26
Ciu Ciu, Contrada Ciafone, Le Marche, Italy, 2015 <i>Trebbiano, Pecorino, Passerina</i> Very quaffable. Complex, yet approachable, this Le Marche wine is a perfect example of one made with focus.	7 / 15 / 29
Force Majeur, Mother Rock, Swartland, South Africa, 2016 <i>Chenin Blanc</i> The single-vineyard grapes are hand-picked from 32-year-old bush vines. This wine is all about fruit purity & minerality with notes of stone fruits on the nose.	7.5 / 17 / 34
Screaming Betty, Delinquent Wine Co, Riverland, Australia, 2015 <i>Vermentino</i> Crazy name for a very shy wine. Clean, easy to drink & traditional. A clean start to the meal or a loyal, sturdy long-term companion.	8.5 / 18 / 37
Turbul, Quealy , Mornington Peninsula, Australia, 2014 <i>Friulano</i> Slightly salty, cloudy & juicy. Structured, if a little playful, with an intriguing intensity.	9.5 / 20 / 41
Epicuria, Volubilia, Domaine de La Zouina, Meknes, Morocco, 2015 <i>Chardonnay</i> Big & attention-grabbing custard apple, quince and green almonds palate. Epicuria offers all the exoticism of its provenance while staying true to its winemakers' Burgundian origins.	10 / 21 / 44
Grand Itata Blanco, Rogue Vine, Itata, Chile, 2014 <i>Moscatel, Riesling</i> A nose of orange blossom & lemon peel of the Moscatel foiled by the dryness of the Riesling. The grapes are hand-harvested from wild bush vines growing in the valley since 1551.	11 / 24 / 47
Domaine Pierre Frick, Pfaffenheim, Alsace, 2015 <i>Riesling</i> Wild yeasts, no added sulphur & a very taut structure. Citrus fruits balanced with apricots & nectarines.	53
"Particella 928", Cantina Barone, Fiano di Avellino, Italy, 2009 <i>Fiano</i> If you are a Fiano-fiend, this is your wine. Fruity, wild & aromatic, a great value wine that will cut through the more intense flavours. Low-intervention wine that's pitch-perfect.	14 / 30 / 58
Pouilly Fume "La Demoiselle", Domaine Henri Bourgeois <i>Sauvignon Blanc</i> Rich & complex on the nose welcomes an elegant texture with a palate of green plum and quince. La Demoiselle is harvested on the Kimmeridgian marls of Saint- Laurent l'Abbaye, where the first vines of this AOC were planted.	16 / 35 / 72

ORANGE

Viejas Tinajas, De Martino, Itata, Chile, 2015 10.5 / 23 / 46

Muscat

Vibrant muscatel aromas, floral flavours, a hint of honey and super dry finish. A good introduction to orange wine and great for a fleeting pre-dinner glass or to have a few bottles of.

Zeste, Domaine Les Sablonnettes, Loire, France, 2015 13.5 / 29 / 55

Chenin Blanc

Intriguing orange wine, a slightly effervescent drop with a lightly honeyed & citrus palette leading towards a richer-than-anticipated finish. Good summertime drinking.

ROSE

Corbières Rosé, Château Ollieux-Romanis, Languedoc, France, 2015 6 / 16 / 30

Carignan, Syrah, Grenache

A very lightly tinted rose. Uncomplicated & approachable, this does what a rose wine should.

Donkeyjote, Vinicola Corellana, Navarra, Spain, 2013 6.25 / 12.5 / 26

Garnatxa

The richness of red cherries & plums anchored with the clarity of a green tea finish. A generously-bodied red that easily matches our spicing.

Cedre Heritage, Cahors, France, 2014 7.5 / 16 / 32

Malbec

A defiant fight-back from the French against the ubiquitous new world Malbecs. Good, firm tannic structure & ink-black in the glass.

Diem, Chateau Tire Pe, Bordeaux, France, 2015 8 / 17 / 34

Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon

Buyoant & easy-drinking. Ripe red and black fruits dominates a lightly-tannic palate.

PUR, Beaujolais Villages, France, 2016 8.5 / 18 / 37

Gamay

A sincere Gamay. Fresh berries & dense minerality lend a substantiality to this light red.

Un Brin de Causette, Domaine des Sablonnettes, Loire, France, 2014 9 / 19 / 40

Cabernet Sauvignon

Energetic Cabernet Sauvignon that's a strong reflection of the Loire region. A nose of charcoal & caramelised figs' palate with an acidic finish.

Les Terrasses, Pascal Lambert, Cravant les Coteaux, Chinon, France, 2014 10 / 21 / 44

Cabernet Franc

The wild, herbaceous nose sits alongside a spicy palate making it a perfect match for our cuisine. Pascal Lambert has been following biodynamic wine making methods since 2005.

Fatalone, Gioia del Colle, Puglia, Italy, 2009 11 / 25 / 48

Primitivo

Big, bold & brash, it speaks of lost lunches celebrating Puglia's culinary traditions. Clean, juicy texture that never betrays the rewarding body of this delicious Primitivo.

'Lo Tumilet', Bodegas Abanico, Priorat, Cataluna, Spain, 2014 12 / 26 / 52

Garnatxa Negra

30-year old vines yielding a ripe & concentrated red with pronounced minerality. The vines are grown on broken slates which lend Priorat wines their unique character.

Musk Creek, Quealy, Mornington Peninsula, Australia, 2013 13 / 28 / 54

Pinot Noir

Musk Creek is a native timber-covered valley that folds down towards the sea. The location & land allows for aromatic wines with high natural acidity. Not a rich wine, this is a well-balanced, clean & lively drop.

Populis, Living Wines Collective, Orinda, USA 2014 60

Carignan

Lively, fresh & engaging. For us, this is an organic wine with soul & story. Made by a wine co-operative with an aim to "bring wine to the people, but not just any wine".

Barbaresco "Roccalini", Cascina Roccalini, Piemonte, 2013 15 / 34 / 73

Nebbiolo

Cinnamon & nutmeg on the nose leading to a palate of violets, pepper & black cherries. A winter for all seasons made by Paolo Veglio who's family-owned winery has been operating since the 1920s.
